- Unique tabletop stand looks great on any table or desk




CARDIOID










Preliminary Setup With Windows Vista

- Plug the free end of the provided USB cable into the USB port on your computer . Your computer will automatically recognize the USB device.
- START menu > Control Panel > Sound To select the LoKI Microphone as your default recording device, begin at your START menu. Select Control Panel.
- Select (Double-click) Sound.
- Select the Recording tab. Make sure that the LoKI microphone is set as the default recording device .(You should see a green check mark beside the USB microphone icon.)




Your preferences are now set to use the LoKI with Windows Vista with the recording programme of your choice.

Preliminary Setup With Windows 7/10



- Piug the free end of the provided USB cable into the USB port on your computer. Your computer will automatically recognize the USB device.
- START menu > Control panel > Sound To select LoKI Microphone as your defarding device, begin at your START menu. Select Control Panel.










- Select Sound.
- The following screen will pop up.
- Select the Recording tab , and choose LoKI Microphone as the default device.
- Double click on the LoKI icon to open the Microphone Properties window. Select the levels tab to adjust microphone level (loudness). You may need to come back to this window to readjust the level after you begin recording.

Your preferences are now set to use the LoKI with Windows 7/10 with the recording programme of your choice.




Preliminary Setup With Mac Os X



- Plug the free end of the provided USB cable into the USB port on your computer . Your computer will automatically recognize the USB device.
- To select the LoKI as your audio input, first open your System Preferences.

Note: Many recording software programmes are available online. Audacity is a widely used free software for recording and editing sounds.



- Next, click Sound to display the Sound 3 preference panel.
- Click the input tab and select the LoKI Microphone as the device for sound input.


Your preferences are now set to use the LoKI on your Mac with the recording programme of your choice.



Preliminary Setup With Mac Os X





- Plug the free end of the provided USB cable into the USB port on your computer . Your computer Will automatically recognize the USB device.
- To select the LoKI Microphone as your default recording device, begin at your START menu.
- Select Control Panel.
- Select Sounds and Audio Devices.
- Adjust computer volume by clicking on the Volume button beneath the Sound recording default device.
- Through the Wave In window, you can set the computer volume or mute the microphone.
